

Super Easy and Fast Hogwarts spell books

You will need 8 sheets of regular printer paper (or parchment for a cooler look) and 4 sheets of cardstock.

Print covers on cardstock, fold and slip first pages into cover. (see photos)

Optional – write your own spells, potions, etc. inside!

These are all the books listed for the first year at Hogwarts in The Sorcerer's Stone



Fold printer paper into 8 and cut as shown



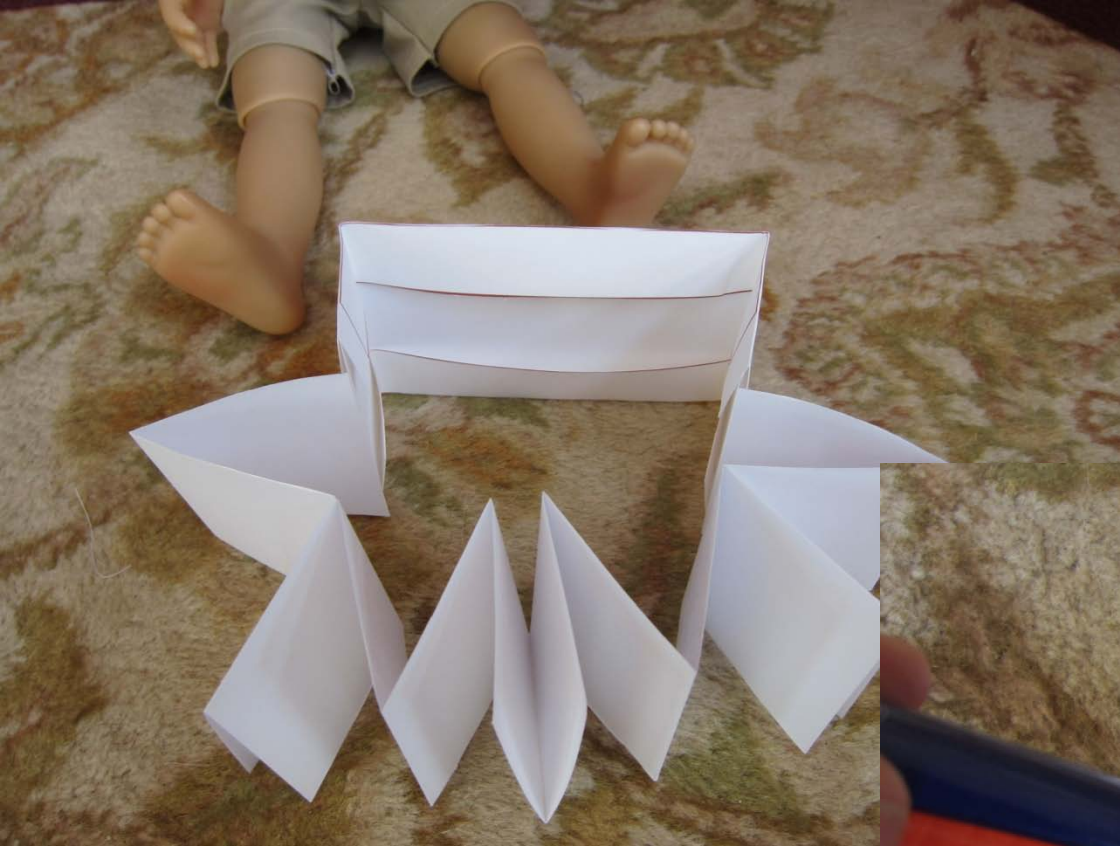
Cutest doll prop ever (although actually made for people) is the Spyderco Bug (It's made of steel and it really folds up!!) available here:

Cut out covers, score folds and fold pages as shown.

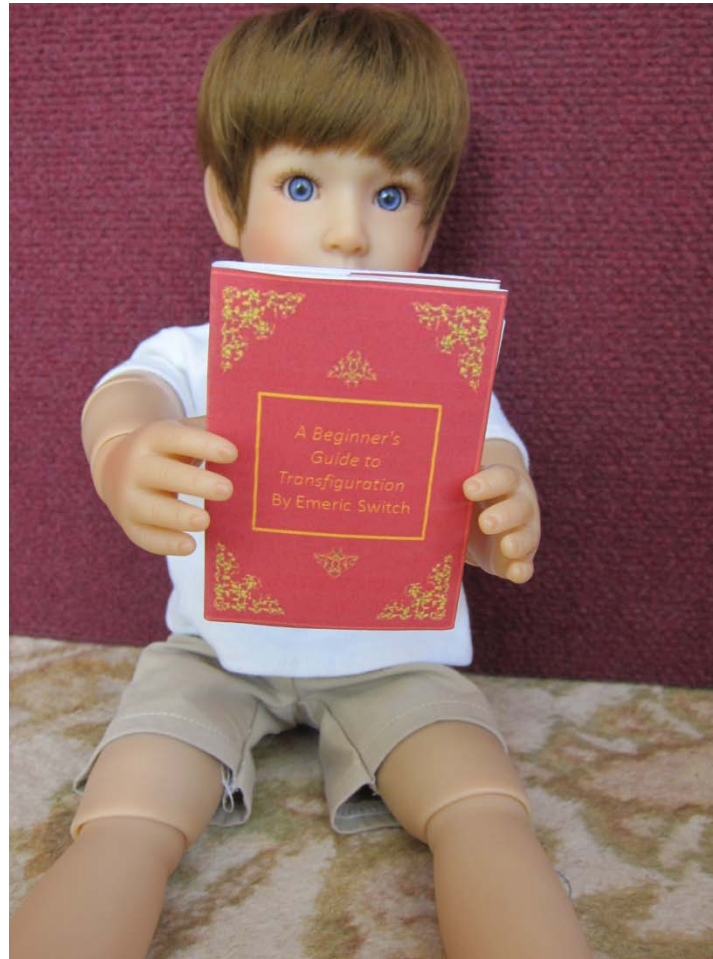


If you want, you can glue down the flaps before inserting the pages. Weight under a book, etc. until dry

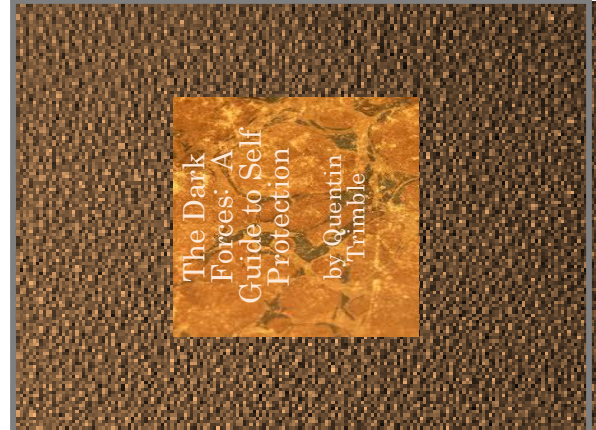
