

1880's pattern

Kidz n Cats
Chest: 8.5"
Waist: 8"
Head: 10-10.5" (this may vary a little based on head mold,

Trendon Sasha:
Chest: 8.75"
Waist: 8.25"
Head: 10"

Magic Attic/Carpatina,
Chest: just under 9.5"
Waist: 8.75"
Head: 11" (this may vary a little based on head mold)

This pattern includes:

- Jacket
- Instructions to use Fairy Bodice #1 to make dress



Notes:

- Seam allowances are ¼" unless otherwise specified.
- **Print the patterns with no scaling. There is a mark on each page showing an inch. Match that to a ruler and make sure it's correct.**
- Patterns are designed to close flush in the back, so appropriate closures would be Velcro, buttons with loops or hooks and eyes.

Cut a strip of muslin or batiste 10"x5" and a strip of sheer fabric such as netting 20"x5"

Gather the top and bottom edge of the netting and place on top of the muslin, adjusting so most of the fullness is distributed in the center. Baste to muslin at top and bottom.



Cut out lining using fairy bodice #1, layer on top of your gathered strip and sew around the top and backs



Cut out, clip where necessary, turn and baste all 3 layers together at bottom.






Hem a strip of skirt fabric so the total length is 5.75" (allows .25" seam allowance) and pleat onto bodice. It's hard to know how wide this piece needs to be, since the depth of your pleats may vary from mine. Figure on at least 25" or so and trim if needed.
