

Wren ★ Feathers

Fairy cottage for 18" Dolls

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I assume you have basic sewing knowledge and the pictures should suffice, but if you need help please email me!

This design is perfect for 18" or smaller dolls. At least 2 dolls can fit comfortably inside, yet it collapses to a small pile of poles and fabric which is easy to store.

Total cost for poles and fittings was under \$10, and if you sew you can probably scrounge fabric scraps from your stash or use an old sheet.



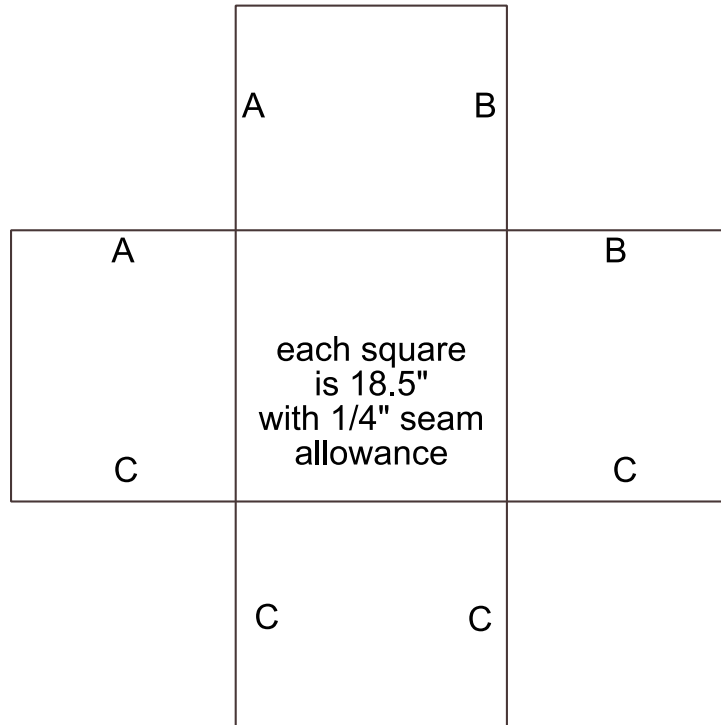
You will need:

- 1 ½ yds of fabric (or 5 fat quarters)
- Felt scraps, silk flowers/leaves, ribbons, etc
- ½" PVC pipe (12' total) **If you don't have a saw or just don't want PVC dust at home, the hardware store will generally cut these for you for a small fee.**
 - Cut 4 pieces 16" for the frame
 - Cut 4 pieces 17.5" for the legs
- 4 - 3-way elbow connectors (I found these at Lowe's. On their website it's called "90-Degree PVC Sch 40 Side Outlet Elbow" – item #315498)
- If you are anti-PVC you can also make 4 hardwood blocks and use them as connectors for wooden dowels – think square tinker toys

Put Frame together like this:



Cut 5 squares 18.5" and sew four squares of fabric to center piece with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Then sew at A-A and B-B following this diagram:

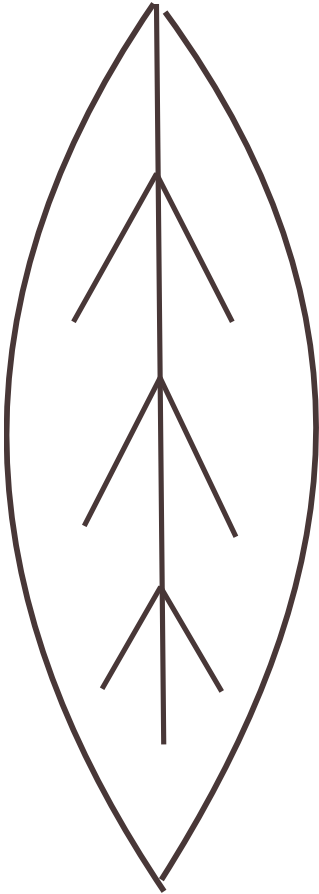
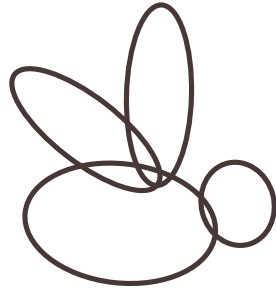
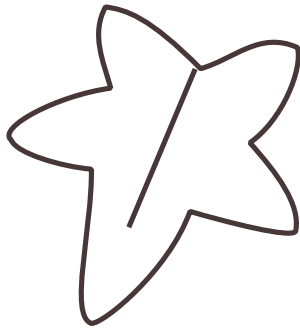


Hem at sides marked C (this will be a flap to fold up to allow play access inside) and all along the bottom. If you want, attach ribbon ties or Velcro to this flap to be able to tie it open or closed. Hem or attach bias binding around door and windows. Decorate as desired.
