## Maplelea Boots

I assume you have basic sewing knowledge and the explanation should suffice, but if you need help please email me!



There are numerous styles of boots in the Arctic. Do a search for "kamiik" (these) and you won't find a whole lot. A more popular term is "mukluks" but those are a little bit different style more common to Alaska than Nunavut. Saila comes with some nice kamiik, but I like this style more. The decorations are just glued-on felt, although in real life they would be fur. These are best in felt and fleece. If you're using fake fur, use the softest, thinnest kind you can get. I broke two sewing machine needles trying to sew up the black part and finally just did it by hand.

These will fit Maplelea, Journey girls, Magic Attic, Karito and Kidz n Cats. No, those dolls don't all have the same size foot, but since these are relatively soft, they'll adapt to fit. I haven't had time to try it yet, but I would bet you could make ballet flats for Maplelea by increasing the upper sole part (maybe about .25") where I put a red arrow on the next page..
