

Wren ★ Feathers

Easy felt clothes for Lottie

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Quarter inch seams allowed on all pieces unless otherwise specified.

I assume you have basic sewing knowledge and the explanation should suffice, but if you need help please email me!






This pattern and tutorial will help you make an A-line dress, top and skirt for your Lottie. Lottie's measurements in inches are:

bust	waist	inseam	between shoulders	neck-waist	head	Height
3	2.75	2.75	1	1.25	4.5	7

The top and dress are made in exactly the same way:



It's not completely necessary, but if this dress will get a lot of use, it will last longer with stitching around the armholes and neckline. The stitching prevents the felt from pulling out of shape with repeated dressing/undressing. This can be done quickly by topstitching on a sewing machine, or if doing it by hand use either a running stitch or decorative stitch such as buttonhole or feather stitch.

Sew side seams. $\frac{1}{4}$ " / 5mm seam allowance is already included at the sides.



Add a contrast border and felt decorations if desired.





The skirt could have topstitching along the top edge if desired, but it's not totally necessary. Just cut out and attach snaps or Velcro where marked on the pattern (pencils point to those spots in the photo). Add felt decorations if desired.
