## A Scrump for your Lilo

**Quarter inch seams allowed on all pieces unless otherwise specified.**

All of the animator dolls come with some little stuffed accessory attached to their hand which, in my opinion, doesn't add much to the play value in most cases. In Lilo's case, it could have, since she does have a rag doll named Scrump in the movie, but the one that comes with her is kind of sad. It's OK for a child to play with, but for an adult collector, I think this one looks nicer on display than what she came with. Although Lilo says she made hers in the movie, this tiny doll was a challenge to make, even for an experienced adult, so I will assume you have experience making tiny stuffies/dolls and know what you're doing before you attempt it!

You might consider making all the parts separately and slipstitching them together instead of how I illustrate it below.
